November 17, 1930 - October 26, 2011

Hermena “Jewell” Manes passed from this life into the loving arms of her Lord the morning of Wednesday, October 26, 2011 at 12:20 a.m., at the Lake Regional Health Care System, Osage Beach, Missouri, at the age of 80 years, 11 months and 9 days.

Jewell was born November 17, 1930, in Pocahontas, Arkansas. She was the only child born to the union of the late Herman Tyler and Jesse (Shepherd) Tyler.

Jewell grew up in Pocahontas and was a 1947 graduate of Pocahontas High School. She attended Southern Baptist College in Walnut Ridge, Arkansas so she could become a teacher later fulfilling her dream as a much loved substitute teacher at Stoutland for several years.

Jewell was united in marriage with Jerry Stephen Manes on October 9, 1957, in Hernando, Mississippi. Together they shared nearly 54 years of marriage until his passing on July 20, 2010 and were blessed with six daughters: Rita, Lizabeth, Jerra, Julia, Margaret and Sarah.
