Jimmie "Sue" Williams, daughter of the late James Vance Tilley and Ada Pearl (Mallett) Tilley, was born September 4, 1954, in Harrison, Arkansas.

Sue, as she was known by her family and friends, grew up in a military family living in several different places, but mostly lived and grew up in the Fort Leonard Wood/St. Robert, Missouri area. She attended Waynesville R-VI School District High School and graduated with the Class of 1972.

In 1979, Sue graduated from the Rolla School of Cosmetology and owned and operated her own salon for 25 years. She loved visiting with all her customers throughout the years and formed lifelong friendships with some along the way.

She entered her heavenly home on Tuesday, December 3, 2024, in the Phelps Health Hospital of Rolla, Missouri having reached the age of 70 years.
