Joanne New Seay, daughter of the late Wade Hampton and Janell (Allen) New, was born October 26, 1948 in Granville, Aiken County, South Carolina. Joanne grew up in Aiken County.

On November 14, 1966, Joanne was united in marriage to Gerald “Jerry” Seay and they were blessed with four children: Jimmy, Joseph, Melissa and Charles.

In 1990, Joanne moved to Waynesville, Missouri to make her home with her brother Robert New.

After moving to Waynesville, Joanne began attending church with Robert at Idumea Baptist Church of Laquey, Missouri. On Easter Sunday morning, April 15, 2001, Joanne made a profession of faith and was baptized the following Sunday.
