Sister Jo Ellen attended Columbus High School in Columbus, Ohio and graduated with the class of 1967. She went on to further her education at Okloosa Waltor Community College in Fort Walton Beach, Florida where she majored in Early Childhood Development.

After college, she entered the work force as a manager for the Fort Walton Beach Community Dry Cleaners. She attended Abundant Life Church of Fort Walton Beach where she would later meet her future husband, Associate Pastor John Morgan of New Beginnings Revival Center.
