John William Leuthen, son of James Joseph Leuthen and Dorothy Marie (Lucas) Leuthen, was born November 4, 1959, in North Kansas City, Missouri.

John began attending school in North Kansas City in kindergarten and did so until the 3rd grade. In 1968, he and his family moved to the Dixon, Missouri area and John began attending the Waynesville R-VI School District from the 4th grade until he graduated from high school with the Class of 1978.

and camping at Pomme de Terre Lake this past summer. She was with him 24/7 during the last six weeks, taking care of him and was a Godsend to his family. John and Barbara had known each other most of their lives, but the last few months was like “the end of their love story”.

John was a member of the Faith Evangelical Lutheran Church of St. Robert, Missouri. He went home to be with his Lord on Wednesday, February 5, 2025, in his home following a courageous battle with cancer and had attained the age of 65 years.
