



## John Truman Quesenberry

January 12, 1926 - December 5, 2014

John Truman Quesenberry, son of the late Charles Homer and Icy Marie (Cook) Quesenberry, was born January 12, 1926 in Hanna, Missouri. Truman, as he was called by his family and friends, grew up mainly in the Bloodland, Hanna, Fairview area, but spent some time in Lebanon.

After graduating from high school, he was united in marriage to the love of his life, Willie Ann Howlett on April 12, 1947. They were blessed with five children: Patricia, John, Bill, Connie Sue and Debra Ann.

Truman was a hardworking man. He worked for Howard Ready Mix for several years and also worked as a civil service employee for a time. His main passion was farming. He enjoyed working on his farm and providing for his family.

At an early age, Truman made a profession of faith and was a member of the Fairview Baptist Church. He was instrumental in rebuilding the church after it was destroyed by fire. He was a faithful member and worked wherever he was able to.

In his spare time, Truman loved riding his horses on trail rides, working in the vegetable and flower gardens, watching squirrels and going fishing. Most importantly, he treasured the times spent with his family and friends.

Truman went home to be with his Lord Friday, December 5, 2014 in the Mercy Hospital of Lebanon, Missouri having attained the age of 88 years, 10 months and 23 days.
