Jonny also liked to surprise people, in 1992 he surprised his fiance, Carolyn, by suggesting they be married at the Bridal Cave in Camdenton. It was a unique, beautiful experience. Jon and Carolyn loved

traveling. Together they traveled all over the U.S. to places like Disney World and Hawaii. Jon was a fan of nonfiction books and old blues music. He and Carolyn also enjoyed camping at various Missouri lakes and parks, especially with his brother and sister in law, Norman and Lawanna Davis.
