



Jose Dano Hipolito

March 19, 1923 - April 22, 2013

Jose Dano Hipolito was born March 19, 1923 in the Philippines. He grew up on Mactan Island in Lapu-Lapu City, Philippines. Jose was baptized into the Roman Catholic Church and practiced his faith until his passing.

Jose was an adventurous man and in 1963, he joined the Merchant Marines where he spent the next 30 years. Shortly after joining, he was assigned to a port in DahNang, Vietnam where he was stationed until the fall of Saigon. His lifelong port was in New Orleans, Louisiana.

In his spare time, he loved to work with cars and anything mechanical. In 1946, Jose moved to Guam. He worked as a welder and as a body and fender technician. Jose was a member of the Richland Masonic Lodge #385 and a lifetime member of the Seafarer's International Union.

Jose passed away Monday, April 22, 2013 in the Sunset Village of the Ozarks of St. Robert, Missouri having attained the age of 90 years. He will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved him.
