Jutta Gerda Burchfield, daughter of the late Helmut Otto and Gerda Ursula Elfriede (Schmidt-Reinko) Schäfer, was born October 27, 1939 in Plauen, Germany.

On November 24, 1972, Jutta was united in marriage to a United States soldier, Luther Leon Burchfield. They were married in Eschborn, Germany and they shared over 42 years of marriage together.

Jutta was a hardworking woman and after moving to the Fort Leonard Wood area, she worked as a housekeeper for several businesses.

Jutta passed away Wednesday, August 19, 2015 in the Springfield Rehab and Health Care Center of Springfield, Missouri having attained the age of 75 years.

Jutta leaves to cherish her memory her husband: Luther Leon Burchfield of the home; other relatives and friends.

Funeral services were held at 11:00 a.m. Wednesday, August 26, 2015 in the Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert with Rev. Christopher Hendrix officiating. The song "Amazing Grace" was played and serving as escorts were family and friends.
