



SFC (Ret) Keith V. Kryger

October 15, 1943 - May 15, 2026

Keith V Kryger was born on October 15, 1943, in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, the son of Lily and Julias Kryger. He joined the Army in January of 1961. He married his first wife in 1965 in California just before going to Vietnam. They had a son named Kenneth.

After his return from Vietnam, he was stationed in Barstow, California. From there he went numerous times to Germany where he met his second wife Ann. They were married in Aschaffenburg, Germany on August 8, 1970. Keith served 25 years in the Army and retired at the end of June 1986. In January 1987, he started Civil Service. In 2002, he medically retired. Keith loved reading and anything outdoors, especially horses. After a long courageous fight with illness, Keith went home to the Kingdom of God on May 15, 2026, at the age of 82.

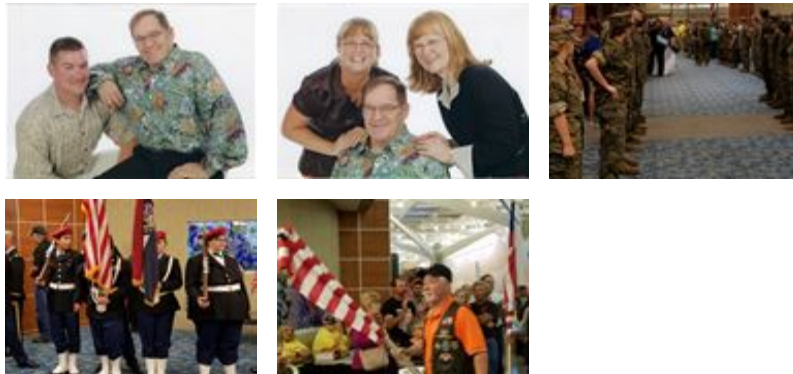
