Kenneth Lee Howlett, son of the late Robert Reed and Grace Lampine (Rollins) Howlett, was born October 24, 1931 near Hanna, Missouri.

As a young boy, Kenneth attended Fairview Country School and then graduated from Richland High School in 1950.

At the age of 13, Kenneth made a very important decision in his life. He accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as his Savior and was baptized. He then became a member of the Fairview Baptist Church.

On November 30, 1952, Kenneth was united in marriage with the love of his life, Armelia Flo Harris. They shared over 59 years of marriage together and were blessed with two sons: Thomas Lee and Donald Ray.

Kenneth was a hardworking man and worked for 17 years at the Post Exchange on Fort Leonard Wood. After leaving the Fort, Kenneth began working for the Pulaski County Road and Bridge and worked there until his retirement.

In his spare time, Kenneth enjoyed raising and riding Missouri Foxtrotting horses and was doing so up until his health started to decline. After his retirement, he was able to spend more time in his woodworking shop and

enjoyed making crafts for his family and friends.

Kenneth was a member of the Berean Baptist Church since 1952 and served as deacon for 36 years. In 2006, Kenneth and Flo began attending Fairview Baptist Church. He loved to sing hymns and if you had the privilege of sitting next to him, you would be able to hear his good bass singing.

Kenneth went home to be with his Lord on Saturday, August 25, 2012 in the Mercy Hospital of Springfield, Missouri having attained the age of 80 years. He will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved him.
