He grew up in Richland, Missouri where he attended school graduating with the RHS Class of 88. After graduating, Kevin went to work for Detroit Tool in Lebanon, then on to Wal-Mart Distribution Center, and later began his career with Major Brands – Breakthru Beverage Distributing for the next fifteen years, where he was employed at the time of his passing.

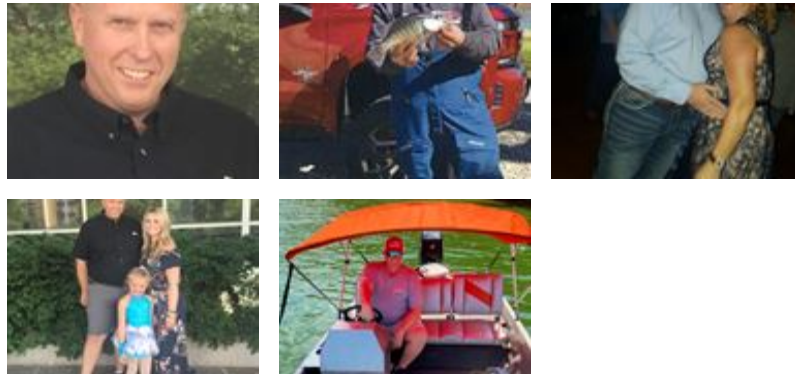
