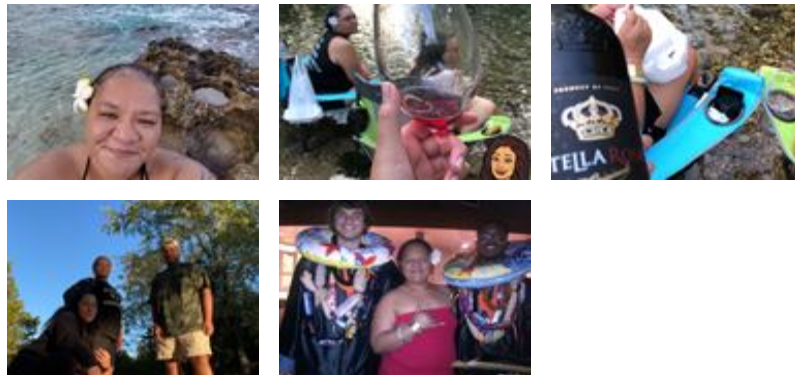

But even years later during my pregnancy and having my first child, she reached out and all she did was congratulate me and tell me how proud she is of the woman and mother I have become. Unfortunately I don’t have the pics we took a long time ago. But the memories I have with her and her family is something I carry years later. As I’m crying, writing this, I’m sure everyone already knows this, but I want to emphasize how great her soul is. How she has really touched my life in a special way in a short amount of time and I’m sure she did with everyone as well. It’s unfortunate her life was cut short but as I grieve, I also want to celebrate her life.
