Kyle Curtis Jones, son of Robert Dale Jones, Jr. and Jodi Lynne (Wright) Jones, was born April 16, 1990 in Fort Riley, Kansas.

As a young boy, Kyle grew up in a military family and they were transferred to the Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri where he began attending school in the Waynesville R-VI School District. He was very involved in different sports throughout his school years and he graduated from Waynesville High School with the Class of 2008. Kyle continued his education and obtained his Associates Degree from Crowder College in Neosho, Missouri in 2010.

In April 2016, Kyle entered the United States Army and served his country until his honorable discharge in May 2018. He had attained the rank of PV2 and earned the National Defense Service Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal and the Army Service Ribbon.

In his spare time, Kyle enjoyed sports, listening to music, reading and hanging out with his friends. He loved his family and enjoyed spending time with them.

Kyle passed away Wednesday, December 11, 2019 in his home having attained the age of 29 years, 7 months and 25 days. He will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those who knew and loved him.
