Kyle Dean Allen, son of Jimmy D. Allen and Robin A. (Skelton) Davis, was born November 19, 1991 in Rolla, Missouri.

Kyle grew up in the Laquey area and attended school. He was a graduate of the 2010 Class of Laquey High School and was very active playing sports while in school. After graduation, he began attending Ozark Technical College in Waynesville where he had completed one year and was presently a student.

As a young boy, Kyle made a profession of faith in Christ at Harmony Baptist Church of Waynesville.

After graduating from high school, Kyle began working at Greek Odyssey on Fort Leonard Wood. He was a hard worker and everyone loved being around him at work.

In his spare time, Kyle enjoyed playing basketball, watching movies and sports, playing his PlayStation and listening to music. He especially liked to hang out with his friends and most of all, spending time with his girlfriend, Kayla who was the light and love of his life.

Kyle passed away at 2:06 a.m. Wednesday, September 28, 2011 as the result

of injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident having attained the age of 19 year, 10 months and 9 days. He will be sadly missed but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.
