



## SFC (Ret) Lee Jackson Farmer

February 18, 1936 - November 10, 2015

SFC (Ret) Lee Jackson “Jack” Farmer, son of the late William J. and Maggie (Stanley) Farmer, was born February 18, 1936 in Alton, Missouri. As a young boy, Jack grew up and attended school in the Alton and St. Genevieve, Missouri area.

Jack enlisted in the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his retirement. He earned several awards and commendations; some of which include: National Defense Service Medal, Army Occupation Medal (Germany), Vietnam Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal w/1st Oak Leaf Cluster, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal w/DVC 60, Good Conduct Medal (2nd Award), Army Commendation Medal w/1st Oak Leaf Cluster, 5 Overseas Service Bars, and CIB. He had attained the rank of Sergeant First Class.

In August 1956, Jack was united in marriage to Charlotte Christa Susanna Mlink in Wiesbaden, Germany. They shared many wonderful years together before she preceded him in death in 2012. They were blessed with four children: Lee Jr., Rebecca, Yvonne, Michael.

After retiring from the military, Jack served as a patrol officer with the Fairbanks Alaska Police Department and also served as a time as Deputy Director for the North Slope Borough Department of Public Safety.

In his spare time, Jack enjoyed classic cars and working in his garden. After moving to the Richland, Missouri area, Jack and Charlotte began attending the Catholic Church. Jack loved to spend time with his family, especially his grandchildren and great grandchildren.

Jack passed away Tuesday, November 10, 2015 in Bonaire, Georgia in his daughter's home having attained the age of 79 years. He will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved him.

Jack leaves to cherish his memory, four children: Lee Farmer, Jr. of Salem, OR, Rebecca Reynolds of Bonaire, GA, Yvonne Keller of Winter Park, FL, and Michael Farmer of Waco, TX; fourteen grandchildren; ten great grandchildren; other relatives and friends.

In addition to his parents and wife, Jack was preceded in death by one brother, Henry and one sister, Dolly.

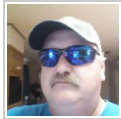
