Leroy Edward Davis was born August 17, 1958, at Ft. McCoy, Wisconsin, one of four sons of the late Floyd Dallis Davis and Shirley Jessica Davis.

On August 17, 1983, in Waynesville, Missouri, Leroy was united in marriage with Pauline M. Aldegon and to this union two children were born, Candace and LeRon Davis.

Leroy became the President of the Prince Hall Builders in 1977, a charter member of the Greater Community Missionary Baptist Church, serving as a Deacon for over 30 years. He also was employed by the University of Missouri Rolla as a campus police officer for over 30 years and received many accommodations.

Leroy enjoyed playing basketball with family and friends. But he so hated to lose and dreaded running up and down the court, so he was known for King “cherry picking”. He loved his family, and he would do anything for them, because the sky was the limit.

Leroy departed this life September 25, 2021, at the Rolla Medical Center. He was loved and will be sadly missed by his two children: Candance, LeRon and his wife, Pauline and his brothers Floyd, Ronald Davis, and his beautiful grandchildren, Cali and Dallis along with a host of family and friends.

Homegoing services were held at 2:00 p.m. Monday, October 4, 2021 in the Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert with Pastor Willie Thornton and Pastor William Boone officiating. 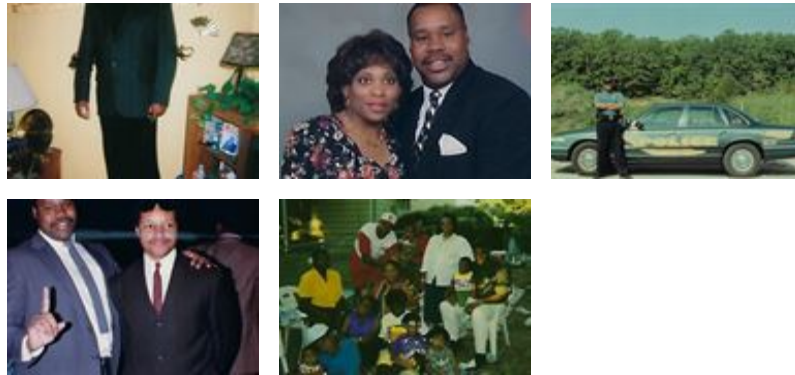
