Lillie Murray, daughter of the late James and Nancy Martin, was born August 29, 1916 in Cherryville, Missouri where she spent most of her childhood and attended school.

Lillie was united in marriage to Everett Estell Murray on July 2, 1935 and they spent many wonderful years of marriage together before he preceded her in death on March 27, 1990. They were blessed with ten children: Herman, Alice, Erma, Raymond, Enkie, Edna, Randy, Henrietta, Clifford and Rosetta.

Lillie was a hardworking woman. She worked for Biggs Cleaners, Jim's Supermarket and the Waynesville Hospital for many years. In her spare time, Lillie enjoyed quilting, cooking and being outdoors while fishing. Most importantly, she loved to spend time with her family, especially the grandchildren and great grandchildren.

As a young girl, Lillie made a profession of faith and was a long time member of New Friendship Baptist Church. She had a strong faith and it was evident throughout her daily life.

Lillie went home to be with her Lord Tuesday, May 19, 2015, in Lake Regional Hospital, Osage Beach, Missouri having attained the age of 98 years.
