Linda Kathleen Perdue was born July 13, 1952 in Waynesville, Missouri. She passed away Sunday, July 14, 2024 at Phelps Health Hospital in Rolla, Missouri at the age of 72.

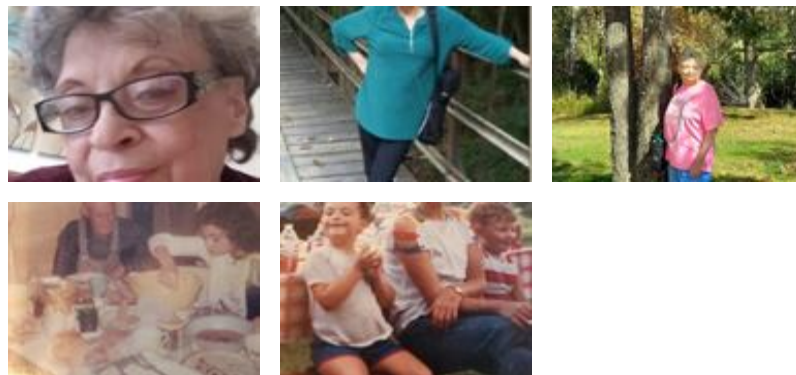
