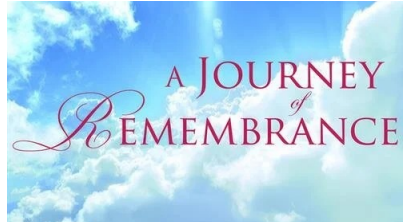
Marc was preceded in death by his father, Jimmy Lee Murphy, Sr. in 2010.

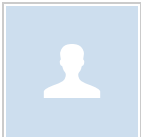
