Margaret Bauder was born July 10, 1925 in Lillington, North Carolina and passed away at 3:55 A.M. Tuesday, December 29, 2009 in the St. John's Regional Medical Center of Lebanon, Missouri. She had attained the age of 84 years, 5 months and 19 days.

Margaret grew up in Lillington, North Carolina and graduated from high school. At an early age, she was baptized and attended the Presbyterian Church.

On May 9, 1942, Margaret was united in marriage to Richard James Bauder. They shared over 49 years of marriage together and were blessed with three children: Richard James, Jr., Brenda and John Frank Bauder.

During her working years, Margaret was employed in food service. She was a hard worker and took great pride in providing for her family.
