Margaret Ann Hutsell, daughter of the late Governor Haskell and Rosa Nell (Decker) Parker, was born June 19, 1940 in Knox City, Texas. She went home to be with her Lord Tuesday, November 8, 2016 in the Mercy Hospital of Springfield, Missouri having attained the age of seventy-six years.

As a young girl, Margaret grew up in Abilene, Texas where she attended school and graduated from high school.

On October 3, 1970, Margaret was united in marriage to the love of her life, Paul Richard Hutsell in Abilene, Texas. Two families came together at their union with their children: Terry, Mitzi and Rick. Paul and Margaret's family was then blessed with Melinda and Jason.

Margaret, Paul and their family lived in Abilene, Texas for a time before moving to the Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri area. While in Texas, Margaret worked for Timex and also had a part time job with Sew Fro Fabrics, which she enjoyed immensely.

At the age 24, Margaret made a very important decision in her life; she accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior and was baptized. From that moment on, her life was never the same. She became a faithful student of the Bible, read it completely through several times and was continuously making notes and

underlining passages in her Bible. Margaret knew her Bible well, was able to quote numerous passages of Scripture and most importantly, she trusted God completely in every area of her life.

Margaret was a member of the Westside Baptist Church and was very faithful in serving. From the time she accepted Christ as her Savior until a few weeks before she passed away, she taught Sunday School from the littlest of children to the older ladies.
