Margarita Guadalupe Cone, daughter of the late Filimon Aguilar and Guadalupe (Velasco) Aguilar, was born February 22, 1945 in Juarez, Chihuahua, Mexico.

As a young girl, she grew up in El Paso, Texas where she attended school and graduated from Bowi High School.

Margarita met a young U.S. States military man by the name of Donald Eugene Cone. They began dating and were united in marriage on May 14, 1967 in El Paso, Texas. They were blessed with three children: Mary Ann, Tammy, and Scott.

Due to Donald being in the military, the family moved several times, but they were transferred to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. Margarita and Donald decided to stay in the St. Robert area after his retirement.
