In early 1961, Margot met a soldier in the U.S. Army, who she fell in love with and the two were happily married on December 29, 1961, in Augsburg, Germany.

During the many moves from Germany to and from Fort Hood, Texas between 1962-1979, Margot was involved with the Non-Commissioned Officers Wives Club, holding and serving various charitable functions while also sponsoring newly arrived military families. 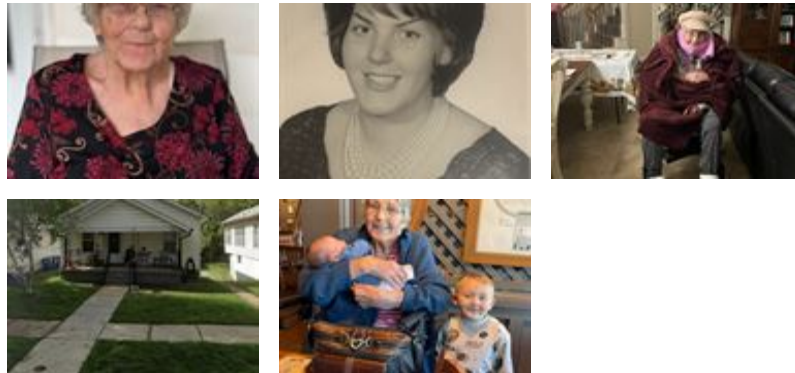
