Marianne (Schuster) Russell, daughter of the late Ernst and Hedwig (Wiesenauer) Schuster, was born May 4, 1946 in Poppenwailer, Germany where she grew up and attended high school. As an infant, she was baptized into the Lutheran faith.

She departed this life Sunday, November 21, 2021 in the Mercy Hospital of Lebanon, Missouri having attained the age of 75 years.

After graduating from high school, Marianne worked at the local tavern where she met Ronald K. Russell (Ron). Marianne left Germany to Idaho Falls, Idaho where she was united in marriage on May 10, 1968. Marianne and her husband moved to Ft. Leonard Wood, Missouri in 1970. They raised three children: Monika, Mona, and Travis.

They owned and operated the Falcon Club in Devil's Elbow, Missouri in the 70's until 1983. Marianne was employed with the America Legion Post #331 (Waynesville-St. Robert) in 1984. Marianne was the Head Bartender and a member as well. She was a member of the VFW Post #3176 where she also held the position of Conductress for the Ladies' Auxiliary Ozark's Memorial.

Marianne leaves to cherish her memory her three children: Monika Shaw, Mona Russell, Travis Russell; a brother: Hans of Poppenwailer, Germany, and

four grandchildren: Dana, Shilo, Hailey, and Kyle. She was preceded in death by her parents and her husband.

She enjoyed gardening, planting her flowers, and feeding her birds in the summertime. Her children had the best mom and dad in the world. Marianne will be missed dearly.

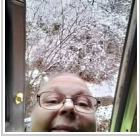

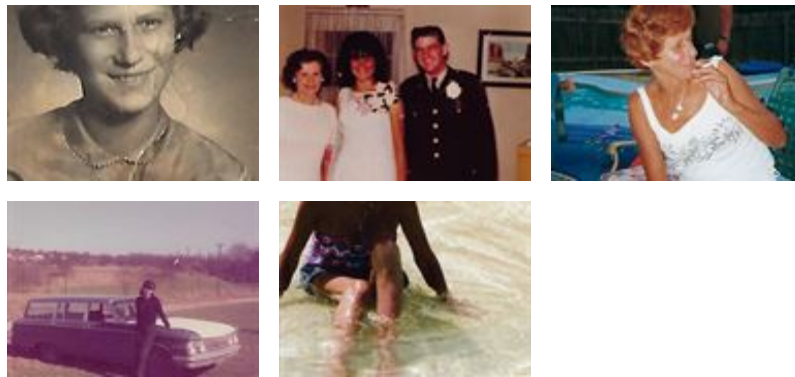
