Marie Moore, daughter of the late Frank and Bertha (Massey) Bookhout, was born April 14, 1934, in Hugo, Missouri, in Camden County. When Marie was 17 months old, her mother passed away, and she was raised by her father Frank, and Grandma Bookhout.

Marie grew up in the Decaturville community. Her early education years were spent in Camdenton, and high school years in Stoutland.

Marie was baptized and confirmed in the Stoutland Methodist Church; the same church where on July 12, 1952, she married the love of her life, Joseph Richard Moore. Marie and Joe shared nearly 60 years of marriage and three wonderful children: Larry Joe, Kathy Sue and Cindy Ann. Her son, Larry, preceded her in death in 1999.

Soon after she and Joe were married, Marie worked in Kansas City for Lazier's Cosmetics and at Hallmark Card Company. Upon returning to Richland, she worked for Lee and Virginia Scheer at Rexall Drug. She worked for a while at the Richland Elementary School teaching remedial reading. Most of her working years were at the H.D. Lee Factory as a finish seamstress. She later served as secretary at the Richland Methodist Church, and helped her daughter and son-in-law, Kathy and John, at their insurance agency, All Star Insurance.

To say that Marie was an animal lover would not accurately describe her love of all animals. Of course she loved her pets, but she also enjoyed watching wildlife and the birds at her bird feeders. She enjoyed her flower gardens, cleaning her house, shopping and boat riding at the Lake of the Ozarks. Most of all, Marie treasured the time she spent with her family and friends.

Marie was a long time, faithful member of the Richland Methodist Church, where she was very involved with church activities. She loved singing in the church choir.

Marie lost her gallant battle with Alzheimer's disease the morning of November 28, 2011, at her home near Richland, Missouri, at the age of 77 years, 7 months and 14 days.

She was dearly loved and will be very sadly missed by her husband: Joe; two daughters: Kathy Parrish (John) of Lebanon and Cindy Frank (Gerry) of Waynesville; seven grandchildren: Dustin Crayton (Amanda) and Eric Crayton (Jamie) all of Springfield, Brandon Moore (Shea) of Ballwin, Jamie York (Ted) and Kelli Henson (Matt) all of Lebanon, Darin Frank (Noelle) of Springfield and Jeremy Frank (Lindsey McMahan) of Waynesville; seven great grandchildren: Sawyer, Allison and Andrew Crayton, Caleb and Carter York and Carsyn and Caysie Henson (and two on the way); nieces, nephews, cousins, an aunt and other relatives.
