Marvin Bradley Erwin, son of the late Marvin Russell Erwin and Ruth (Monk) Erwin, was born April 6, 1948 in Wilkesville Township, Vinton County, Ohio. As a young boy, Marvin grew up in Newark, Ohio where he attended school.

On August 19, 1967, Marvin was united in marriage to Perle Linda McMannis at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. They shared over 52 years of marriage together and were blessed with two children: Melinda and Mike.

Marvin enlisted in the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his retirement after 20 years of service.
