Mary L. Patton, daughter of the late Willard Anderson and Nancy Jane (Exendine) Gan, was born June 16, 1931 in Bloodland, Pulaski County, Missouri. She passed away on Monday, November 5, 2018 in the Life Care Center of Waynesville having attained the age of eighty-seven years.

On November 6, 1949, Mary was united in marriage to Arthur Lawrence "Pat" Patton and they were blessed with two sons: Danny and Ronny. Mary and Lawrence shared over thirty-three years together and many wonderful memories before he preceded her in death on March 31, 1983. Ronny, Mary's son, also preceded her in death on August 14, 2005.

Mary was a hardworking woman and worked for twenty years as a cook for the Waynesville R-VI School District. She enjoyed cooking for all the kids and teachers and was best known for her hot rolls that she would make from scratch.

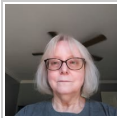
