December 23, 1923 - May 10, 2024

Mary Ann Runtzel, one of 10 children of the late Cecil Christopher Grier and Edith (Holestine) Grier, was born December 23, 1923, in Marshfield, Missouri. Her sister, Jeannie lovingly referred to Mary as “Bobby”.

On November 10, 1948, in Springfield, Missouri, Mary was united in marriage to Otto Andrew Runtzel. They shared over 47 years of marriage together before he preceded her in death on February 18, 1996.

Mary was a hardworking woman and took great pride in helping to provide for her and Otto’s two girls, Stephanie and Debra. She worked at Fort Leonard Wood as a civil service employee in the Finance Department and retired after 35 years of faithful service. She made many lifelong friends during her time at Fort Leonard Wood.

Mary was the queen of the kitchen. Her specialties were zucchini breads, fried chicken, roast beef, and homemade noodles. She always made homemade cookies to send home with everyone that came to visit. In her spare time, Mary loved watching the St. Louis Cardinals baseball team and the Kansas City Chiefs football team, especially with a beer and some popcorn. She was a member of the Shrine Wives Club for many years.

The one thing that brought her more joy than anything was her family. They

were very important to her, and she treasured the times that she could spend with them.

Mary was carried to her heavenly home in the arms of the angels on Friday, May 10, 2024, in the Lake Regional Hospital of Osage Beach, Missouri having attained the age of 100 years. She will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved her.

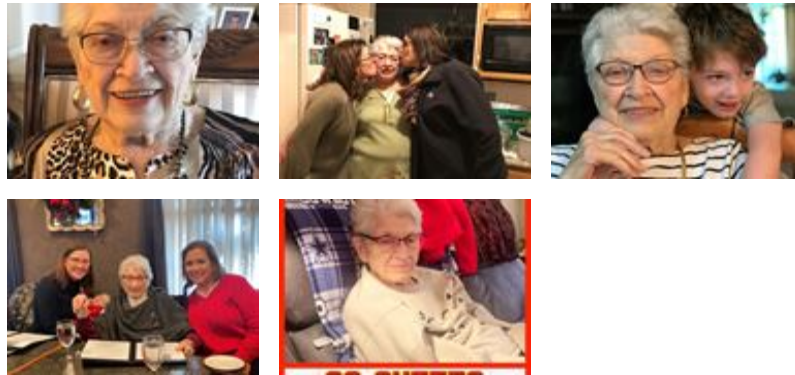
