Mary Anna (Pollreisz) Schutt, daughter of the late Michael Joseph and Laura (Van Natta) Pollreisz, was born December 12, 1928, in Parkston, South Dakota and entered the gates of Heaven on Wednesday, March 19, 2014 in the Lake Regional Hospital in Osage Beach, Missouri having attained the age of 85 years.
