She loved plants of all kinds; her windows were filled with many houseplants and you would find her in the garden outside when the weather was nice.

Although Mary struggled with several health issues, she never complained. The illnesses got the better of her and she went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, March 23, 2023 having attained the age of 76 years. She will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those who knew and loved her.
