Maurice "Moe" Alan George, son of the late Burless L. and Ruth B (Mitchell) George, was born July 2, 1961, in Rolla, Missouri. He departed this life January 25, 2018, in Missouri Baptist Hospital in St. Louis, MO, at the age of fifty-six years, six months and twenty-three days.
