

## Myrtle Catherine Evans

July 18, 1929 - May 3, 2010

Myrtle “Bunny” Catherine Evans passed away at 10:34 A.M. Monday, May 3, 2010 in the Phelps County Regional Medical Center of Rolla, Missouri at the age of 80 years, 9 months and 15 days.

Bunny, as she was known to her family and friends, was born July 18, 1929 in Indianapolis, Indiana where she grew up and attended Decater Central High School. She was the daughter of the late Elmer and Lillian (Jackson) Pierson.

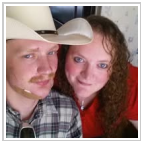
