Nicol Marie Pollreisz was born May 10, 1972, in Columbia, Missouri, to the late Joseph Albert Pollreisz, and Marikay Philomena (Policello) Pollreisz. She grew up in Columbia and attended both Rock Bridge Elementary and High School, graduating with the Class of 91. Nicol furthered her education and went on to attend UCM in Warrensburg, Missouri, and later she attended Columbia College, and Central Methodist in Fayette, Missouri, with a Melee Major.

Nicol began playing the clarinet in the fourth grade; and played all through her college years with the Symphony Orchestra. She also played with the Community Band, and at Our Lady of Lourdes Catholic Church while in Columbia, Missouri. Nicol was a very talented and accomplished clarinet player who loved making music and sharing it with all who would listen.

She was beloved long-time member of St. Jude Catholic Church in Richland, where she blessed the parishioners with her beautiful music in her younger years.

Nicol worked in the food service industry for McDonalds at their various locations in Columbia, Osage Beach, and Camdenton, Missouri, until her health failed. Nicol then moved to Richland in 2013; but later moved to Camdenton, Missouri, with her cousin, and care giver, Jeannine Weiss. Nicol found relaxation while working on puzzles of any kind yet keeping her

mind stimulated by each puzzles challenge.

On the warm summer afternoon of Sunday, August 20, 2023, while in Camdenton, Missouri, Windsor Estates. Nicol went to be with God having attained the age of fifty-one. She is preceded in death by her father, Joseph (2/19/2010) and her mother, Marikay (11/15/2013); numerous aunts and uncles.

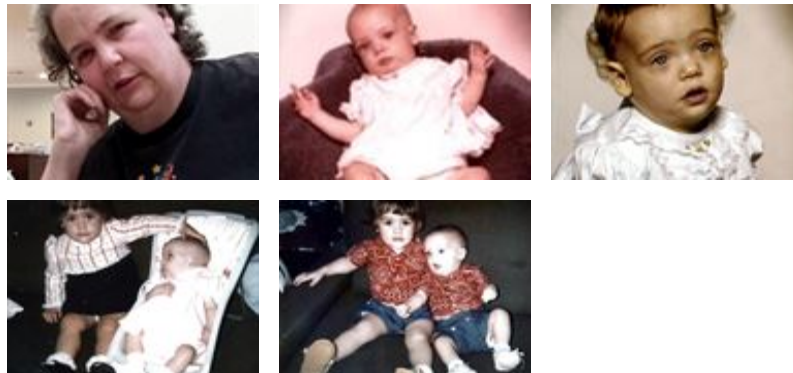
