Pamela Sue Mayer, daughter of Billy Joe Curley and Ruth Ann Ross was born June 3, 1951 in Parrish, Illinois where she grew up and attended school.

In 1970 Pam entered the United States Army proudly serving her country and was awarded the National Defense Service Medal. After her honorable discharge in 1971, Pam pursued a career as a payroll clerk for the Department of Defense where she worked until her retirement from Ft. Leonard Wood, Missouri.

On February 27, 1971 Pamela married John Mack Mayer in Atlanta, Georgia and to this union four children were born. Together they shared over thirty two years of love and laughter until his passing on June 4, 2003.

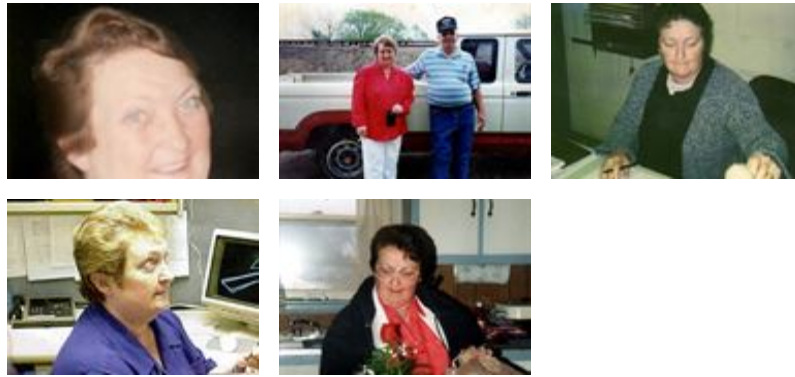
