Paul Thomas Bowles, son of Ernest P. and Ruby L. (Baldwin) Bowles, was born November 29, 1931, near Greenfield, Missouri. He departed this life Saturday, August 18, 2012, in Christian Health Care, North in Lebanon, Missouri, at the age of eighty years, eight months and nineteen days.

On July 3, 1984, he was united in marriage to Linda Kay Reo and they have shared the last twenty-eight years together.
