Phillip Wray Webber, son of the late Wray P. and Mary (Toner) Webber, was born September 6, 1934 in Mullinsville, Kansas. As a young boy, Phillip attended school in Bucklin, Kansas and graduate from Bucklin High School. He furthered his education after high school and graduated from Ft. Hayes State College with a Bachelor of Arts Degree in English.

Phillip enjoyed helping people. He obtained his certification for Counseling and became a Psychology Counselor. He worked as a self-employed counselor for 34 years.
