SFC (Ret) Randall Keith "Randy" Rogers, son of the late Richard Henry and MaDonna Lee (Russell) Rogers, was born February 22, 1956 in Denver, Colorado. As a young boy, the family moved and Randy graduated from high school in Kansas City with the Class of 1974.

Shortly after graduation, Randy entered the United States Army and served his country faithfully for 20 years in various locations around the world.
