Randall Joseph West, or as he was known by his family friends: Randy or “Fuzz”, was born June 26, 1969, in Waynesville, Missouri. Son of Harold Ralph West and Shirley Jean (George) West, Randy grew up in the Pulaski County area and graduated from Crocker High School with the Class of 1988.

In 1989, Randy entered the United States Army and served his country until 1992 and later re-entered in 1999 serving until 2001. He attained the rank of Specialist and earned the Army Achievement Medal (2nd Award), Army Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Army Service Ribbon and the Overseas Service Ribbon.

Randy was united in marriage to Sue Ann McCoy in Buckhorn, Missouri on January 5, 1991. They spent 34 years together and were blessed with two children: Ryan and Autumn.
