Richard Philip Davis, was born November 18, 1945. The last of nine children born to Robert Lester and Jennie Elizabeth McIntyre Davis. He stepped into what may come on Tuesday, January 3, 2023 at 6:35 p.m.

Richard grew up in Presque Isle, Maine. He attended Presque Isle Schools and joined the US Army, serving stateside, Germany, Vietnam, and retiring at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri in 1984.
