



Robert Cagle

June 25, 1946 - December 26, 2008

Robert Wayne Cagle, son of the late Allen Troy Cagle and Jesse Louise Cagle, was born June 26, 1946 in Greene County, Missouri. Robert and his family moved to the Waynesville, Missouri area where he graduated from Waynesville High School.

On July 21, 1965, Robert entered the United States Navy and served his country until July 15, 1969. For his faithful service, Robert received several awards and commendations. He finished his reserve obligation on July 20, 1971.

After serving his country, Robert hauled buildings for Ft. Leonard Wood with his father. Later he drove for Van Lines Trucking Company. He was also a heavy equipment operator for many years.

Robert passed away at 12:30 A.M. Friday, December 26, 2008 in the Harry S. Truman Veterans Hospital of Columbia, Missouri at the age of 62 years, 6 months and 1 day.

Robert will be sadly missed, but remembered by his friends and all who knew and loved him. He is survived by three children: Janet Martin of Richland, MO, Nancy Greer of Camdenton, MO and Mika Cagle of Columbia, MO; several grandchildren; other relatives and friends.

A memorial gathering was held from 1:00 – 2:00 P.M. Tuesday, January 27, 2009 followed by military honors. Military honors were provided by American Legion Post 298 of Dixon, Missouri and the United States Navy and the song “I Can Only Imagine” was played. Services were under the direction of Memorial Chapels and Crematory.
