



SFC (Ret) Robert Dail "Bob" Fraser

August 12, 1948 - July 31, 2023

Robert Dail "Bob" Fraser, son of the late John W. Fraser and Laura L. (Atooun) Fraser, entered this world on August 12, 1948, in Fresno, California. He departed this life on Monday, July 31, 2023, in the Lake Regional Hospital of Osage Beach, Missouri having attained the age of 74 years.

As a young boy, Bob grew up in Fresno where he attended school and graduated from high school.

Shortly after graduation, Bob entered the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his retirement in 1991. He had attained the rank of Sergeant First Class and earned several awards and commendations; some of which included: National Defense Service Medal (2nd Award), Army Service Ribbon, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Overseas Service Ribbon (3rd Award), Mechanic Badge, Army Good Conduct Medal (8th Award), Sharpshooter Qualification Badge M-16 Rifle, Noncommissioned Officer Professional Development Ribbon (3rd Award) and the Meritorious Service Medal.

On October 2, 1976, Bob was united in marriage to Sharon Lee Butler in Aberdeen, Maryland. They shared over 33 years of marriage together and in addition to Bob's three daughters, Cherice, Alicia and Laura, the family grew to include: Cassandra, Sheri, John, Bobby, and Terry. Sharon preceded Bob in

death on March 9, 2010.

In the 1980's, Bob and the family moved to Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri and after his retirement in 1991 from the military, they decided to remain in the Pulaski County area.

Bob continued serving, even after his retirement from the US Army, and worked at the prison in Jefferson City for several years before officially retiring.

Bob truly enjoyed retirement life. He loved just being at home, relaxing, drinking his favorite beverage and visiting with family and friends. He especially enjoyed spending time with his grandchildren and treasured every chance he could have with them.

Bob will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by all those that knew and loved him.
