



Robert "Morgen" Lierd

September 13, 1941 - June 7, 2018

CSM (Ret) R. Morgen Lierd passed away on the eve of June 7, 2018 after a long battle with Parkinson's. He had attained the age of 76 years.

He is survived by his wife, Pamela of the home; one daughter: Kimberly Brucie of Horseheads, NY; one granddaughter: Aryn Brucie, as well as a host of other relatives and friends.

Morgen entered the United States Army in 1961 and retired in 1988. He has served in France, Belgium, Germany, South Vietnam and several posts in the United States. While serving, he earned several medals: Silver Star, Bronze Star, three Purple Hearts, Legion of Merit, Meritorious Service Medal and many more.

When he retired, Morgen worked as a civil service employee at the Fort Leonard Wood Army Community Hospital for fourteen years.

Morgen was a very active athlete. He formed running clubs, and participated in triathlons. He was also a member of the international running club, Hash House Harriers.

Morgen was also active in the Disabled American Veterans Chapter 49 as a member of the flag and honor guard.

Morgen enjoyed wood working, fishing and traveling. He will be sadly missed, but fondly remembered by family and friends.

Graveside services with military honors were held at 3:30 p.m. Monday, June 18, 2018 in the Missouri Veterans Cemetery of Waynesville, Missouri with United States Army Chaplain Josh Metz officiating. Military honors were provided by the United States Army of Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. Services were under the direction of Memorial Chapels and Crematory of Waynesville / St. Robert.
