Robert Allen Perry, son of the late Lester and Hortence Perry, was born January 7, 1941 in Oakfield, Wisconsin where he grew up and attended school.

In 1959, Robert enlisted in the United States Army and served his country faithfully until his retirement in 1979 after 20 years of service. He had attained the rank of Sergeant First Class. For his service, Robert earned several awards; some of which include: National Defense Service Medal, Army Commendation Medal, Republic of Vietnam Campaign Medal, Good Conduct Medal (6th Award), Mechanic Badge with Bar, Meritorious Service Medal, Expeditionary Qualification Badge M16, Vietnam Service Medal w/3 Bronze Service Stars, Meritorious Unit Commendation, and several other awards.

In October 1962, Robert was united in marriage to Erika Briesach in Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. They shared over 46 years of marriage together and were blessed with one daughter: Roswitha.

Robert and Erika were members of the Crocker Assembly of God Church and attended every time they could.

Robert went home to be with his Lord at 6:28 P.M. Sunday, May 3, 2009 in the General Leonard Wood Army Community Hospital of Fort Leonard Wood,

Missouri at the age of 68 years.
