



Robert Edward "Robbie" Robbins

August 6, 1927 - July 9, 2010

Robert Edward "Robbie" Robbins, son of the late J.E. and Alice Marie (Atchison) Robbins, was born August 6, 1927 in Paragould, Arkansas and went home to be with his Lord at 10:50 P.M. Friday, July 9, 2010 in his home.

Bob grew up on a farm in Haliday, Arkansas and attended the Newberry School. As a young boy, he accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior and was a member of the New Liberty Baptist Church in Marmaduke, Arkansas.

On November 20, 1950, Bob entered into the United States Army and served his country faithfully during the Korean War. He was honorably discharged on November 25, 1952, having attained the rank of Corporal. For his faithful service he was awarded the Korean Service Medal, United Nations Service Medal and one Bronze Service Star.

Bob married the love of his life, Virginia Myrl Fred on January 3, 1953 in Piggott, Arkansas. They shared over 57 years of marriage together and were blessed with four children: Edward, Freddy, Darlene and Venetta.

Bob worked for many years as a farmer while living in Arkansas and as a carpenter. He and Virginia moved to the Waynesville area and he began working as an ironworker. He was a member of the Ironworkers Local 396 in St. Louis. His primary jobs were on Fort Leonard Wood. He was a member of

the Francis J. Lynch VFW Post 3168 of Laquey and the American Legion.

In his spare time, Robbie enjoyed working in his vegetable garden and was especially proud of his tomatoes. He liked to cook and be outdoors while fishing. He enjoyed getting together with his friends and family and play a good game of cards. Most importantly, he loved being with his family and friends. He will be sadly missed by all those that knew and loved him.

Robbie leaves to cherish his memory his wife: Virginia; four children: Edward Wayne (Patricia) Robbins, Freddy Bob (Bambi) Robbins, Darlene McDonald and Venetta Robbins, all of Waynesville; sister: Madge Keen, Paragould, Arkansas; brother: Ervin Robbins, state of Illinois; step-brother: Leo Johnson, St. Charles; step-sister: Martha Stokes, Paragould, Arkansas; six grandchildren; four great grandchildren; nieces, nephews, other relatives and friends.
