Visitation will be held from 4:00 – 6:00 P.M. Friday, May 15, 2009 in the Memorial Chapels of Waynesville/St. Robert.

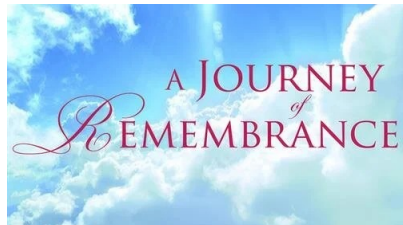
