Ronald Lee Henson, son of the late John B. and Geraldine (Shelton) Henson, was born November 14, 1950 in Crocker, Missouri, and passed away November 30, 2017, surrounded by his family in Richland, Missouri, having attained the age of 67 years.

Ronnie made a profession of faith in Christ and followed in baptism. He later attended Beulah Baptist Church of Richland, Missouri.

He was a graduate of Stoutland High School in 1968. After graduation Ronnie entered into the United States Navy proudly serving his country until his honorable discharge.

He greatly enjoyed breaking and riding horses. He loved life and never met a stranger. If Ronnie didn't know you, before long you'd

both feel like you had known one another your entire lives; he was that kind of guy, always joking around. Ronnie just wanted to enjoy the simple things in life; watching a good western, a cold beer, a good horse and a long trail ride. However his most prized possessions were his friends and family, especially his grandkids who brought fun and excitement into his life.

Ronnie was preceded in death by his parents, grandparents, his beloved son, Spencer Lee Henson (August 22, 2015), brother, Danny L. "Bodie" Henson, brother-in-law, Wayne Crosby and his father-in-law, Larry Patton.

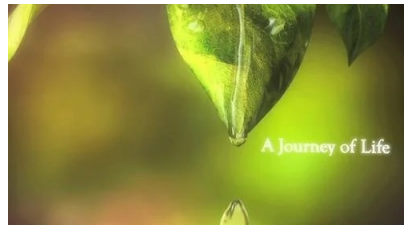

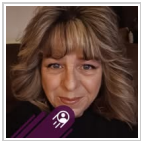

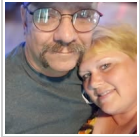
