Ruby May Chadwell went home to be with her Lord at 4:38 p.m., Thursday, January 27, 2011, at Sunset Village of the Ozarks of St. Robert, Missouri at the age of 85 years, 3 months and 5 days.

Ruby, daughter of the late Wesley and Ona (Ervin) Fuller, was born October 22, 1925 in Waynesville, Missouri. As a young girl, she grew up in the Waynesville area and graduated from the Waynesville School District.

At an early age, Ruby accepted Jesus as her Savior and was baptized in 1960. She was a member of the Gospel Ridge Church and attended every time she could.

Ruby was united in marriage to James "Arthur" Chadwell on August 27, 1942. They shared many wonderful years of marriage together and were blessed with two children, Larry and Mary. Arthur passed away on February 8, 1996.

Ruby was a hardworking woman and helped provide for her family. She worked as a dental assistant for several years and in her later years became the head cook for the Waynesville R-VI School System.
