



Sang-Cheol Ahn

December 3, 1927 - January 31, 2017

Sang-Cheol Ahn, 89, of Waynesville, Mo., died Jan. 31, 2017, at Phelps County Regional Medical Center in Rolla, Mo., following a brief illness.

Ahn, a Korean War combat medic, attained the rank of sergeant first class in the South Korean Army and following his military service owned several businesses in Seoul, including clothing sales, food distribution, and a contractor for municipal electric installation in Seoul.

Ahn was born on Dec. 3, 1927, in Gyeonggi Province, South Korea, the son of Kee-Soon Ahn and his wife, Myo-Hee Lee, who preceded him in death. He married Sung-Jae Choi in 1950, prior to the Korean War, who survives him, and to this union five children were born: his daughter Dr. Anne Maurina and her husband Darrell Todd Maurina of the home in Waynesville; daughter Myung-Ok Ahn and her husband Rev. Young-Bok Kim of Gyeonggi Province, South Korea; son Rev. Kwang-Heon Ahn and his wife Hah-Hee Jeon of Seoul; daughter Myung-Hee Ahn and her husband Rev. Yong-Hyung Lee of Gyeonggi Province; and son Chan-Heon Ahn and his wife Tae-Sun Kim of Gyeonggi Province. Survivors also include eight grandchildren; seven great-grandchildren; and numerous siblings and other relatives in Korea.

The funeral was held at 11 a.m. on Saturday, Feb. 11, at Memorial Chapels of Waynesville, with visitation preceding at 9 a.m. and burial followed in the

Waynesville City Cemetery. The service was in English with Korean translation provided.
