SGT Joshua Louis Kline, son of Jeffrey Louis Kline and Karen S. (Winkler) Kline, was born December 13, 1984 in Cincinnati, Ohio. As a young boy, Joshua and the family moved to the Waynesville, Missouri area and he graduated from Waynesville High School.

After graduation, he attended Ozarks Technical College in Springfield, Missouri. He then enlisted in the United States Army in January 2007 and attended Community College of the Air Force.

While in the Army, Joshua worked as a Biomedical Equipment Specialist and as a Supervisor of Communications for Research. He earned several awards and commendations while in the military.

In his spare time, Joshua enjoyed collecting comic books and action figures, playing video games, listening to music and watching movies. He had just begun learning to play the guitar. Most importantly, he loved spending time with his family and friends, especially his two sons: Seth and Dillon.

Joshua passed away May 5, 2012 at Fort Hood, Texas having attained the age of twenty-seven years.
